Code of Conduct for all participants in Thornton Heath Community Action Team's events, meetings, social media (including emails, Facebook, Twitter)

All participants in Thornton Heath Community Action Team's events, meetings and social media must conduct themselves in a way that does not cause offence to others or bring THCAT into disrepute.

They must treat others with respect and must not make remarks or carry out actions that are racist, sexist or derogatory.

They must allow others to speak without interruption or other inappropriate behaviour.

They must be aware of the agenda and time limits of meetings, keeping their contributions to the point.

They must be sensitive to the needs of those who may not be used to speaking in public or whose first language is not English.

Those who feel that this Code of Conduct has been breached should raise the matter with the Chair (or in her absence, Committee Members) at the earliest opportunity for the Chair to take appropriate action, including removal from meetings and/or membership of THCAT.
